## UDVC Library

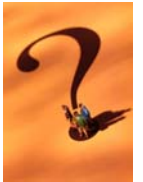

*Live Basic Domestic Violence Training*

Since the UDVC agreed to take over the Live Basic DV Training we have trained more than 460 people! This a great number, but one we are looking to improve on.

Something new for 2007 will be the length of the training. In 2005 the



training went from 40 to 20 hours; in 2007 we will be using a standardized curriculum that will provide 24 full hours of training to attendees.
